**FAIRPORT HARBOR PUBLIC LIBRARY HOSTS “I REMEMBER WHEN”  
A MEMOIR WRITING WORKSHOP**

On Saturday, July 11<sup>th</sup> the Fairport Harbor Public Library will host “I Remember When...” a memoir writing workshop conducted by Lake Erie College English professor and author Amy Kesegich. This workshop invites participants of all ages to recover treasured memories through a gently structured series of writing exercises that encourage free association and self-reflection. Persons participating the workshop will receive a notebook to record their memories during the workshop. Afterwards they may take it home with them to continue adding to their personal stories for themselves and to share with family members. They can also enhance it with photographs, drawings, or mementos.

Amy Kesegich is a Professor of English at Lake Erie College in Painesville, Ohio. She previously was Chair of the English Department at Notre Dame College in South Euclid, Ohio. Kesegich holds a Ph.D. from Case Western Reserve University in English Language and Letters. She is also a published author and has published poetry in *Whiskey Island*, *California Quarterly*, *Frost Notes*, *Poetry Motel*, *White Pelican Review*, *Rubbertop Review*, and *Poetography*. Her first full-length poetry collection, *Some Complaints About Time*, will be released on September 11, 2026 by Finishing Line Press. Kesegich resides in Fairport Harbor, Ohio with her husband.

The workshop will be held on Saturday, July 11, 2026 from 11:00 a.m. to noon in the Fairport Harbor Public Library Conference Room. This event is free and open to the general public.
